Many adverbs are simply adjectives with an -ly added onto the end. Practice turning the following adjectives into adverbs. (*Spelling hints: If the adjective ends in a y preceded by a consonant, change the y to i before adding -ly; ex. happy-happily. If the adjective ends in an l preceded by a vowel, keep the l and add an additional -ly; ex. careful-carefully. If the adjective ends in e, if it's a one-syllable word, keep the e and add -ly; if it has more than one syllables, drop the e and add -ly.*)
