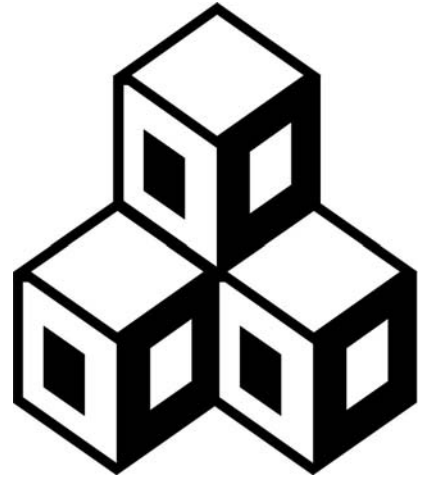

Types of Relative Clauses Worksheet

There are two types of relative clause. Both types modify nouns, but the first type makes a noun more specific, while the second type adds extra facts or information about a noun. Think of it as building blocks to enhance your writing.
