

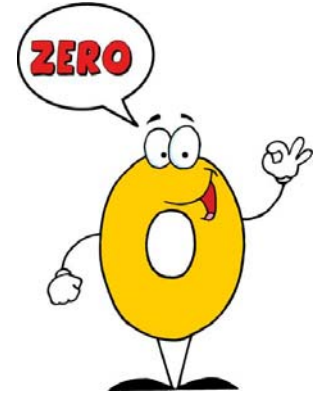

Zero Conditionals

A Zero Conditional is something that is generally true. Usually *if*, *when* and *unless* are used.

For example: Unless you want to get wet, use an umbrella.
