## Interrogative, Exclamatory, & Declarative Sentences

All sentences begin with a capital letter. A **declarative** sentence is a sentence that tells something and ends with a period. An **exclamatory** sentence is a more excited or emotional version of a declarative sentence, and ends in an exclamation point. An **interrogative** sentence is a sentence that asks something. Interrogative sentences end with a question mark.

### Declarative Sentence:

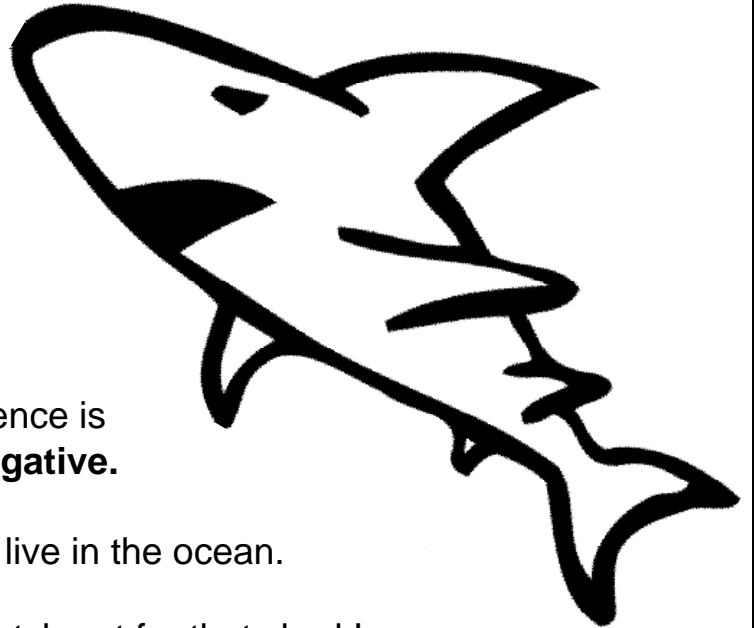
*Sharks are my favorite animal.*

### Exclamatory Sentence:

*I can't wait to see sharks at the zoo!*

### Interrogative Sentence:

*What is your favorite animal?*
