What Owns You?

Possessive nouns are used to show ownership. Make a singular noun possessive by adding an apostrophe and an "s" to the end.

EXAMPLE: The dog belongs to Karen. Karen's dog
 The toy belongs to the cat. the cat's toy

If the noun already ends in "s", just add an apostrophe to the end of the word.

EXAMPLE: The mitt belongs to the Charles Charles' mitt
 The aroma belongs to the cake the cake's aroma
