In Case Of Emergency

If you are ever involved in an emergency then you should know what to do. An emergency is when you need help from the police, fire department, or an ambulance right away. If you need help right away from one or more of these people then you should call 911. When you call 911 an operator answer the phone and will ask what your emergency is at the time. The operator will also ask other questions like: What is your emergency?; What is your exact address at this moment?; What is your name?; and What is your phone number?
