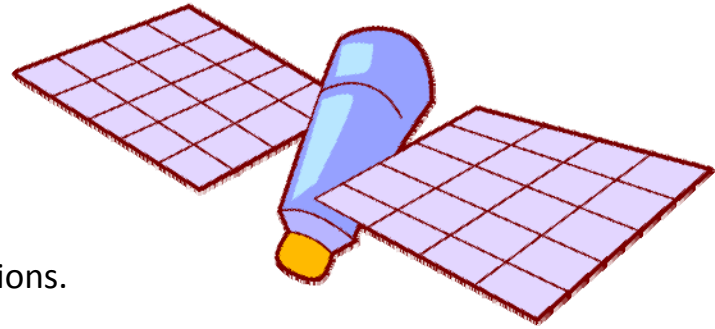


Satellites
