Talking About the Future: Will | Be Going To

There are two ways to express that you are talking about something that is going to happen in the future.

Present: I go to school.

Future: I will go to school tomorrow.

I am going to go to school tomorrow.

Use **will**:
To make decisions that are made at the time of speaking
To state a fact about the future
To make a promise
To make a prediction
With words like *I think, I hope, I guess, probably and possibly*

Use **be going to**:
If talking about a future event that has been planned before the time of speaking
To make a future prediction based on facts or evidence
