## Question Tags



A question tag is a short question at the end of a sentence that asks for confirmation from the listener. Form a question tag by using a negative question after a positive sentence, or a positive question after a negative sentence. Use the auxiliary verb and pronoun from the sentence.

**EXAMPLE:** I didn't mess that up, did I?  
She hasn't forgotten, has she?
