

A Class Cookbook

Directions: For this project you will use a computer to compile and publish a Class Cookbook.

1. Your assignment is to contribute three recipes. The recipes can be family recipes that you type up, one recipe per page, or they can be recipes that you find online for things that you would like to try to cook. Wherever you find your recipes, you must type them onto individual pages yourself; do not cut and paste your recipes.
2. Choose one student in the class to compile the recipes into a single file, or your teacher may do this. You may e-mail your recipes to that student/teacher, or provide them on CD.
3. When all the recipes are in one file, the “Cookbook” can be printed. Design your own cover for your copy of the Cookbook. Compile the pages into a notebook, or staple them together. Now take it home and try out your classmates’ recipes for yourself!
