How to Cite Books

Citing sources is an important aspect of being a responsible scholar. It shows your reader that you have done proper research, gives credit to other researchers and acknowledges their ideas. Citing your sources also allows your reader to track down those sources for him or herself if they would like additional information on your topic.
