

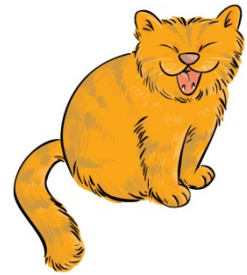
Identify and Use: Suffix –ed
