

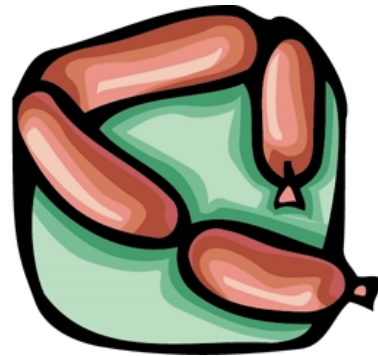
Prefix pre-
