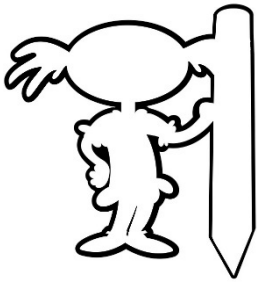


Picking At It
