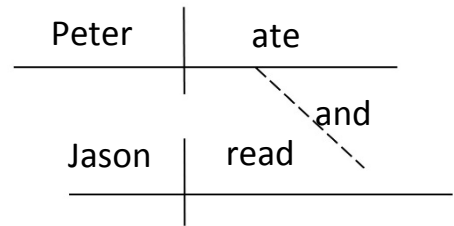


Dissecting Sentences
