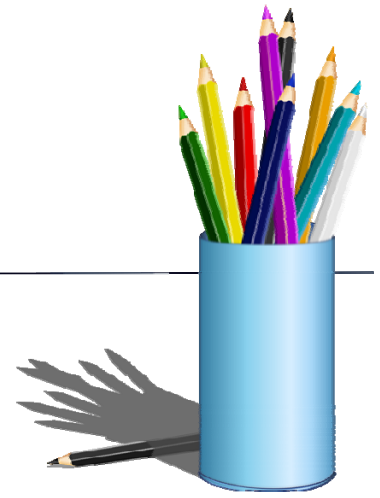


Bank It of the Side
