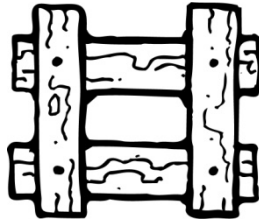

An indirect object is a word or phrase that tells *to* or *for* whom it is being done. It can be a person, a thing or even an animal.



Example: Doug built a fence for his dog.

Built is the verb, directing towards fence. Fence is the direct object in this sentence. Dog is the indirect object. It is *for whom (or what)* the fence was built.
