# Substitute Nouns

Pronouns are substitutes for nouns. A singular pronoun is used to substitute a single noun. A plural pronoun is used to substitute nouns that are plural.

Examples:

The **bird** built **his** nest out of sticks and feathers. **Bird** is the **singular nouns**, and **his** is the **singular pronoun**.

The **birds** built **their** nests out of sticks and feathers. **Birds** are the **plural nouns** and nests are the **plural pronouns**.
