

Types of Sentences

There are four kinds of sentences in the English language. The structure for each type can differ in verb tense, word order and in punctuation.

Imperative: Gives a command.

Declarative: Makes a statement.

Exclamatory: Expresses strong feeling.

Interrogative: Asks a question.
